She had served as the Administrator at the Golden Spread Nursing Home in Shamrock as well as serving Wheeler County as Justice of the Peace in the Lela precinct. While working full time, Maulcie also operated Lee's Tax Service for 30 years, where she retired from that just last year. She was an example of a Proverbs 31 woman and always had a giving spirit. She had spent the majority of her life in Shamrock, except for about four years that were spent in Lazbuddie. She was a Christian.
