Lore met and fell in love with Gary Ferguson, Specialist 4th Class Head Quarters Company Nurnberg, Germany, while he was serving his country in the US Army from 1955-1963. They married in Bamberg, Germany on March 25, 1958 before coming to America and making a home. They were married 55 years. Although she left her home country she held proud to her strong German heritage. She was a living expression of "you can tell a German, but not much." It was that unbending character that helped her learn to live in a new country and start a family. Lore worked at the Hall County Hospital for over 20 years. She enjoyed her grandchildren first and foremost. Her hobbies were sewing, collecting spoons, bells, and angels. She was also actively involved in her church, First Assembly of God in Memphis for many years.
