Juanita had an interest in the world and its wonders, enjoyed attending the theatre, held season tickets to the symphony wherever she lived, and surrounded herself with interesting and adventurous people. She delighted in creative accomplishments, was a dedicated employee, and an inspiring mother. Her friends in Clarendon may remember her as adventuresome and daring. Many of her friends remember her as someone who rarely backed away from a challenge. Her last few years were difficult because of the illness that developed in her later life.
