Mr. Quisenberry was born June 27, 1906 in Richland Springs, Texas to Joseph William and Florence Elizabeth Burleson Quisenberry. He married Jewell Anna Dickson on October 31, 1931 at Hollis, Oklahoma. He had been a farmer, drove heavy equipment for Donley County, and managed the Hedley Lumber Company.
