INTERMENT - Citizens Cemetery Mrs. Shadle was born in Wise Co., Texas to Franz Joseph and Delia Bridget Conner Koeninger. She married Thomas Marvin Shadle on May 16, 1923 in Wise County. She, her husband, and infant daughter moved to Donley County in 1925. After a brief stint of moving from one oil field to another, including Borger, they settled back in Donley County where they farmed and ranned for over 60 years. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Clarendon.
