Pat was also a Chief Appraiser at Young County and was the longest standing appraiser in the same office in Texas serving for 23 years. He was a member of the American Legion Adamson-Lane Post 287 in Hedley and the Naval Enlisted Reserve Association. Pat was also a volunteer firefighter and was a past member of the Howardwick Volunteer Fire Department where he served as Assisitant Chief. Later he joined the Clarendon Volunteer Fire Department, where he was currently a member and serving as Assistant Chaplain. He was a member of the Clarendon Church of Christ.

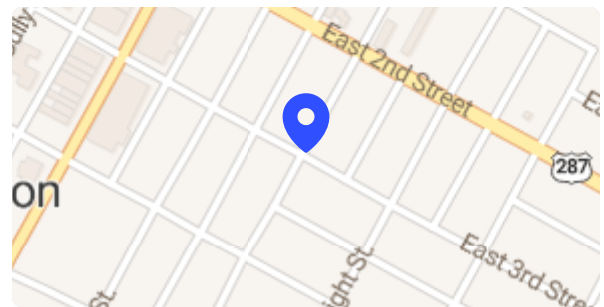

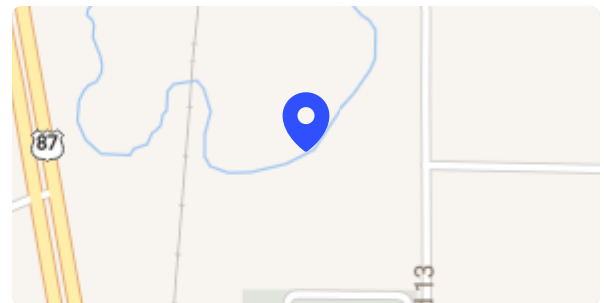

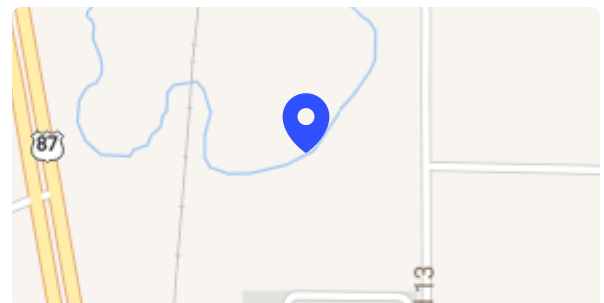
