Visitation will be held at the funeral home on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 from 5 pm to 7 pm

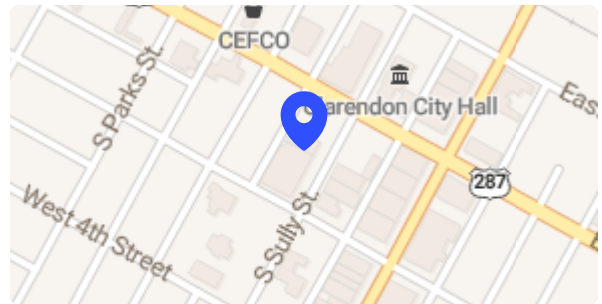

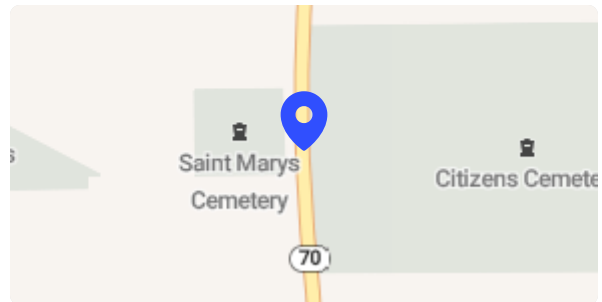
