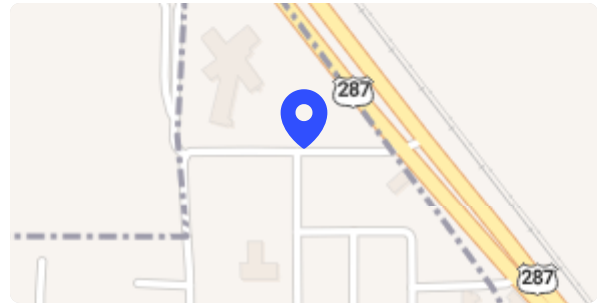
PRECEDED IN DEATH BY – his parents, Harbert and Bertha Penney; his brothers Carl, Jake, and William; and by a sister, Helen.

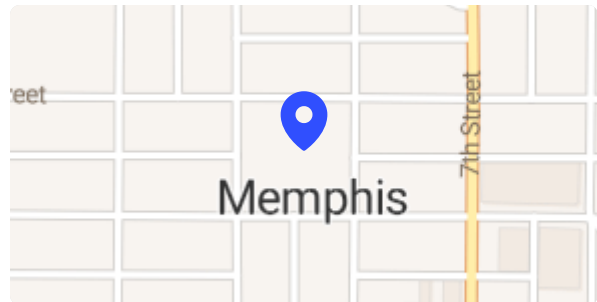

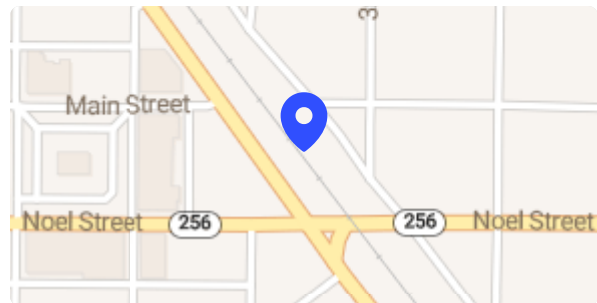
