Tom married Glenna Belle Shields on May 22, 1956 and they moved to Jericho in 1959 and then to Groom in 1972. He faithfully attended the Groom Church of Christ. Tom and Glenna were foster parents for High Plains Children's Home for at least 18 infants. Tom ran the Jericho Gas Station and did custom hay baling. He loved sharing his garden of watermelons, tomatoes, cantelopes to the community. He dearly loved his family.

PRECEDED IN DEATH BY – his wife on January 24, 2011; 2 sons, Ronny Reed in 1969 and Kent in 2008; 3 brothers, Bob, John, and Joe Reed; and a sister, Evelyn.

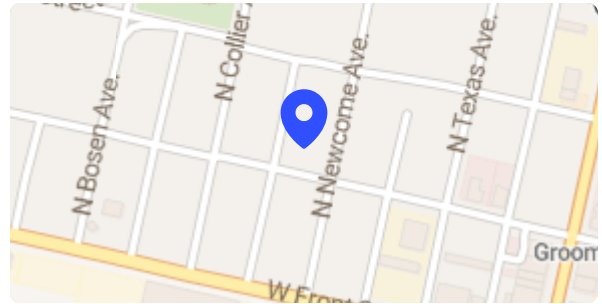

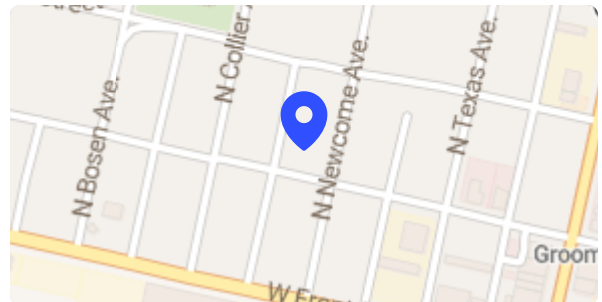

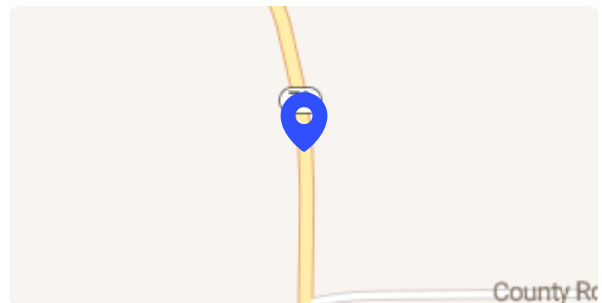
