BIOGRAPHY-Born May 5, 1932 in Turkey, Texas, to Cecil Price and Merry Velma Hunter Price, Roxie was the third of ten children and eldest daughter. She was baptized at a young age at First Baptist Church Quitaque. She attended Quitaque Schools, where she met the love of her life, Earnest Wayne Barbee. They were married June 29, 1950, and celebrated 65 years of marriage before Earnest passed away in 2015.

Roxie devoted her life to being an exemplary wife and mother. Together, they raised three children. She worked side by side with Earnest in the cotton fields, raised a large garden and canned vegetables every summer and fall, while keeping the books on the family farming business and an immaculate home. Roxie was active in her church, First Baptist Church Clarendon, where she taught Sunday School, was a leader in WMU, and volunteered with funeral meals and visiting shut-ins and the sick. She was also a charter member of Donley County Young Homemakers.

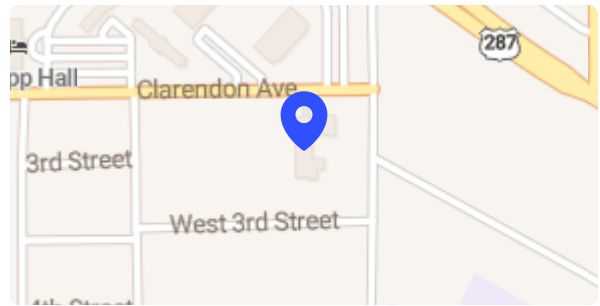
