MEMORIALS- in lieu of flowers the family suggests that donations be made to the Alzheimer’s Association.



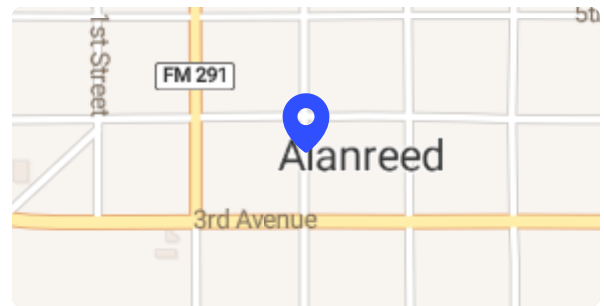

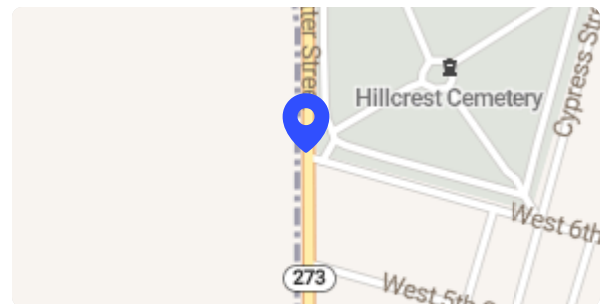
