The family request memorials be sent to the Memphis Convalescent Center.

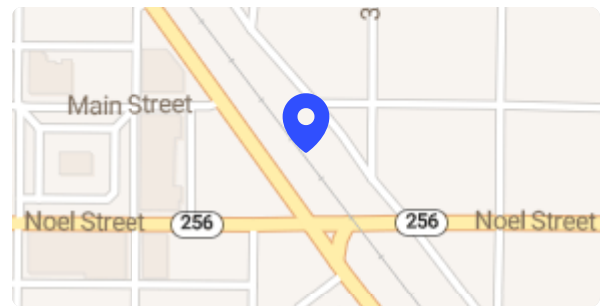

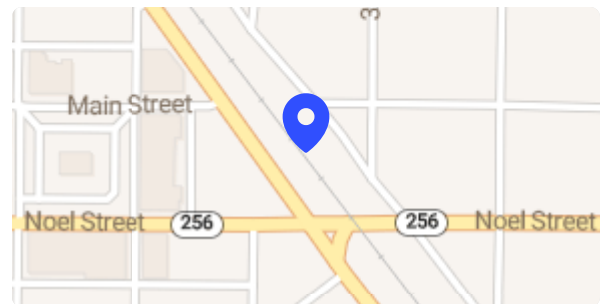
