**P**erry William White, 80, of Goodnight died Tuesday, January 29, 2019 in Goodnight, Texas.

Memorial Services will be held 2:00-4:00 PM Saturday, February 23, 2019 at McPherson Cellars Winery, 1615 Texas Avenue, Lubbock, Texas 79401. .

Cremation & Arrangements are by Robertson Claude Chapel.

Perry's wishes were to have his ashes scattered over the ocean at Cabo San Lucas, Mexico where him and his sons avidly fished for marlin.

Perry was born July 12, 1938 in Muleshoe, Texas to Walter Lee and Lena Shields White. He grew up in Lubbock and graduated from Lubbock High where he was an athlete. He married Patsy Painter of Lubbock and later married Sidney Mills of Pampa. He was very adventurous and liked salt water fishing, hunting, and skiing. He also loved horse racing, cattle, and the ranch life. Perry was a great father.

He was preceded in death by his parents; the mother of his sons, Patsy Painter Sanders; and several brothers and sisters.

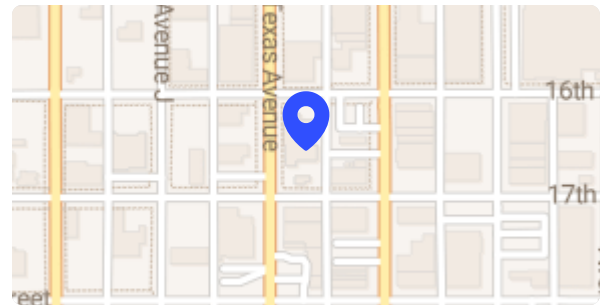
