He was preceded in death by his parents; 3 brothers; a sister; and a great grandchild, Ellie Jeffers.

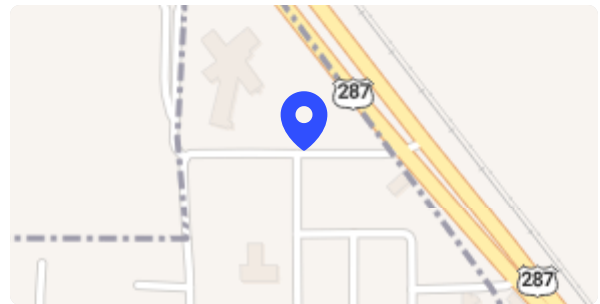

The family request memorials be sent to March of Dimes in honor of Ellie Jeffers.



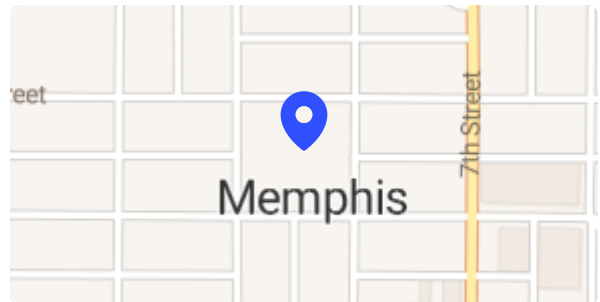

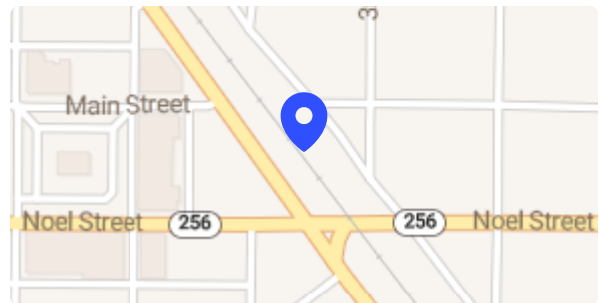
