The family request memorials be sent to the Memphis Convalescent Center in Memphis.

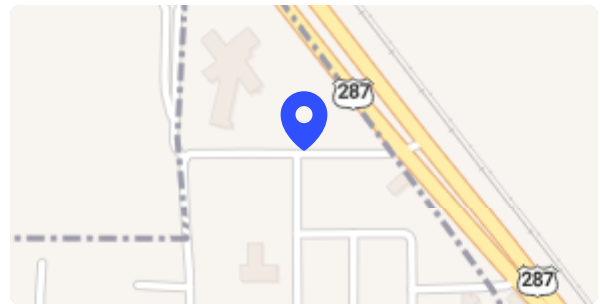
