He had worked at Pantex and retired after 39 years in November 1993, where he finished his career as the Department Head of Metrology. While living in Amarillo, He coached youth through Kids Inc. He served on the school board at River Road ISD for 8 years and served as President of the board. While on the school board at River Road, he was a part of getting the new High School built. J.W. served on the ANSI committee as Secretary and Chairman for several years and was president of Hocheim Insurance board for several years. He loved all breeds of horses especially race and quarter horses. He also enjoyed farming and ranching. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Claude.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, on September 18, 2008; and two brothers, Winston and Tommy Noble.

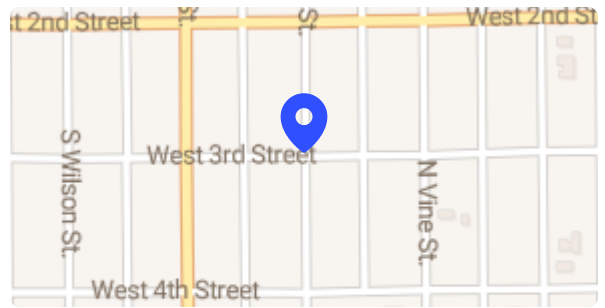
