Thomas "Corky" Eugene Berry of Sweetwater, Oklahoma, passed away on October 21, 2020.

Graveside service will be held at 10:00 A.M., Saturday, October 24, 2020, at the Walker Ranch Cemetery in Sweetwater, Oklahoma.

Arrangements have been made by the Robertson Funeral Directors in Wheeler, Texas.

Thomas "Corky" Eugene Berry, 84, of Sweetwater, Oklahoma, passed away from this life October 21, 2020, to his eternal reward with the Lord and Savior.

Corky was born and raised in Tulia, Texas, on December 4, 1935, to Jack and Katharine Berry. He was the oldest of four siblings—Ray Lynn, Lafone, Francis, and Debra. He served in the United States Army from 1958-1960. Upon his return from Germany, he married Julia Fay Culwell. Together they resided in Tulia for many years raising three children—Karl, Carmen, and Celia—on a homestead south of town where his son Karl still lives today. Corky was an avid horseman, a World Champion Steer Roper, and a man with many stories to share.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister Lafone Holligan, his brother Ray Lynn "Slim" Berry, and granddaughter Kaci Dawn Howard.

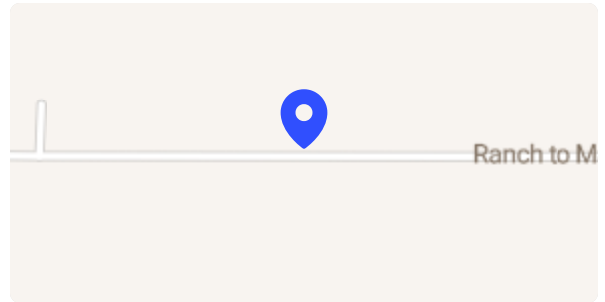

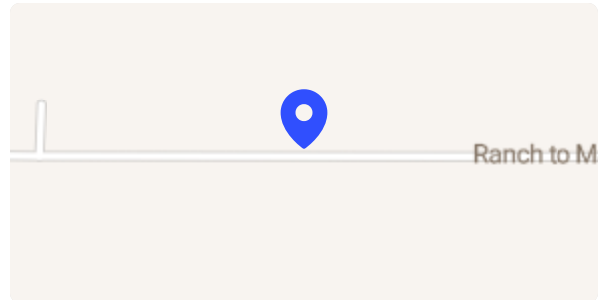
