Sherrie Christine Martindale, formerly of McLean died Saturday, November 28, 2020 in Wellington.

Sherrie was born December 22, 1936 in Abra, Collingsworth County, to Hugh and Stella Miller Grogan. She married James Coy Martindale on June 26, 1955.
