Andres Garza, 96, of Memphis, died on Saturday, December 19, 2020 in Amarillo.

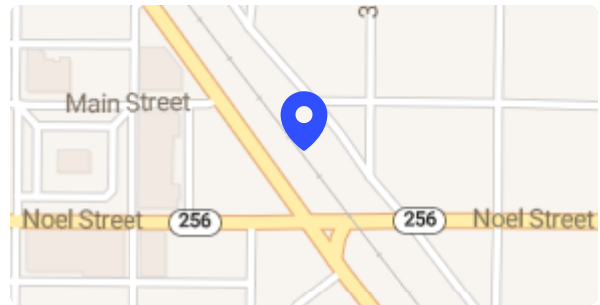
