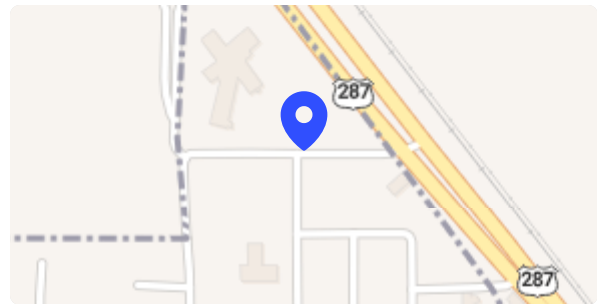
He was preceded in death by his parents; and numerous brothers and sisters.

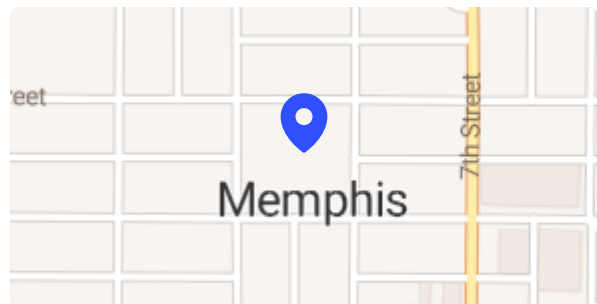

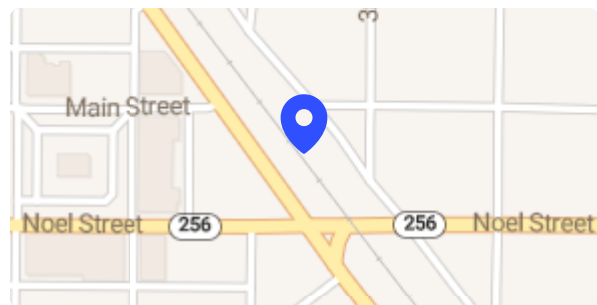
