He was preceded in death by his father in 2010 and his grandparents.

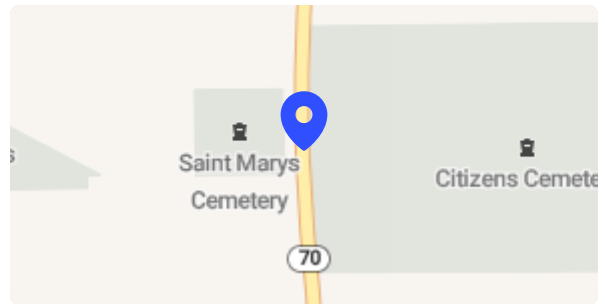

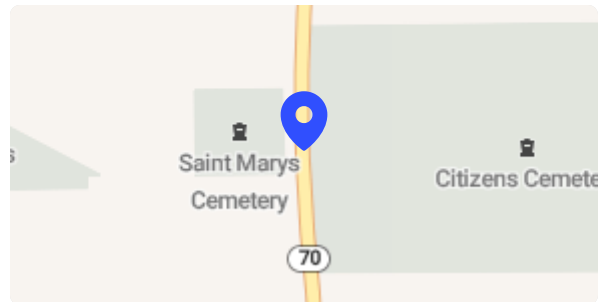
