Ida Mae Goad, 91, of Wheeler, TX went to her Heavenly home on April 14, 2021 after a long bout with lung cancer.

Services are planned for 10:00 AM Saturday, April 17, at the Wheeler Church of Christ with Carroll Thomason and Garrett English officiating. Burial will follow at the Wheeler Cemetery in Wheeler, TX. Arrangements are by Robertson Funeral Directors of Wheeler.

Ida Mae Martin Goad was born December 18, 1929, the only daughter of Pyrmon and Ardie Sivage Martin. She is survived by two brothers, Happy Martin of Farmington, NM and Bob Martin and wife Elaine of Briscoe, TX. Ida Mae graduated from Wheeler High School and married William Andrew Goad (Dub), July 19, 1947 at the age of 17.
