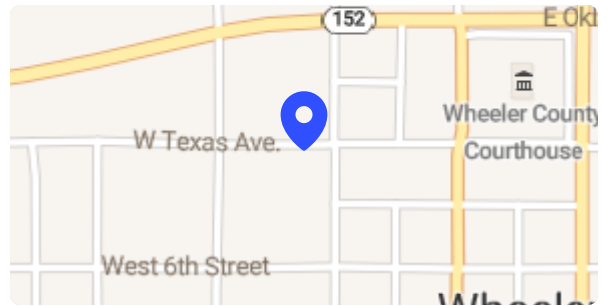
He was preceded in death by his parents; his son, Kent; his brother, Bruce; and sister, Gayle Candell.

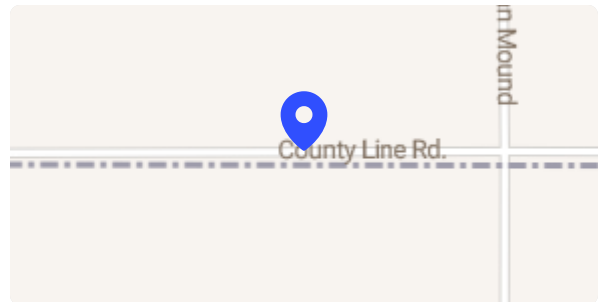

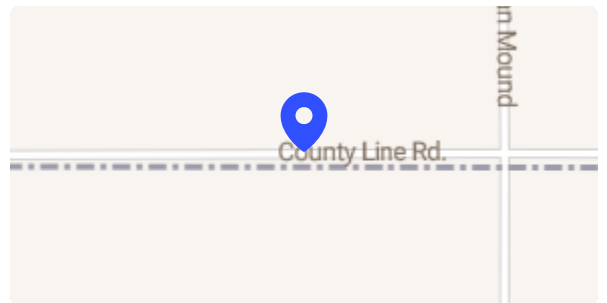
