Loyd Dean Messer passed away Thursday morning, August 19. Loyd was born June 19, 1944 in Memphis, Tx. He was raised in Hedley by his parents L.D and Dorothy Messer along with his older brother Roger and younger sister Delores.

Loyd enjoyed growing and harvesting peaches around Hedley in his early years farming with his father.

He later moved his young family to Morse, Tx. where he owned and ran a fertilizer business.

Loyd then moved to Gruver and was employed by Dean Cluck where he took care of much of the farming operations for Dean Cluck Feedyard for many years, he then spent some time in Mountain View, Ok. where he owned and operated a service station, later returning to Gruver for a short time before moving on to Center Point, Tx. helping Monte Cluck again with odd and end jobs and owning his own pecan tree operation in the Hill Country where he finally retired and moved back to Wellington, Tx. close to his old stomping grounds just a short time ago.

Loyd was a jack of all trades and would give the shirt off his back to anyone in need.

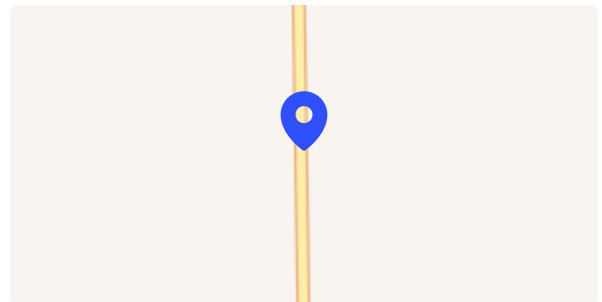

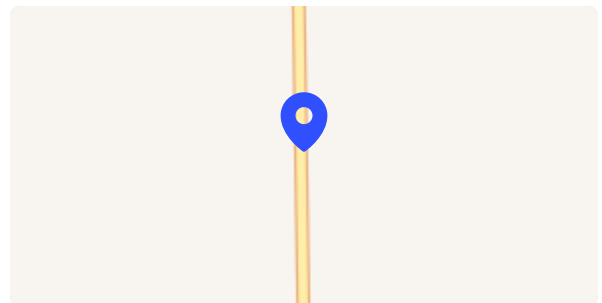
