He graduated from McLean High School in 1959 and attended Southwestern Oklahoma State University where he earned a bachelor's degree on a football scholarship. Later he returned to Weatherford and earned a master's degree in counseling, and still later, he earned an administrative degree from the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville.

He married Lynna Carter June 25, 1971, in Clarendon, Texas. 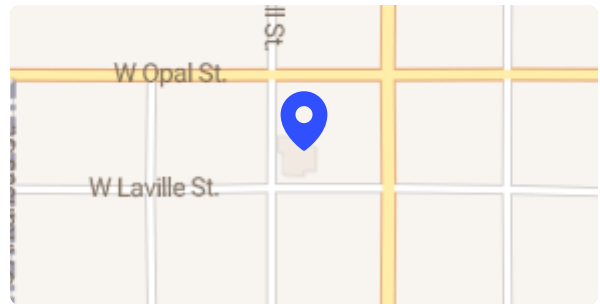

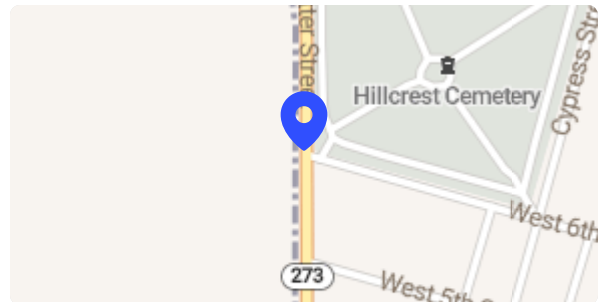
