In lieu of flowers, the family requests memorials be made to a favorite children's ministry.

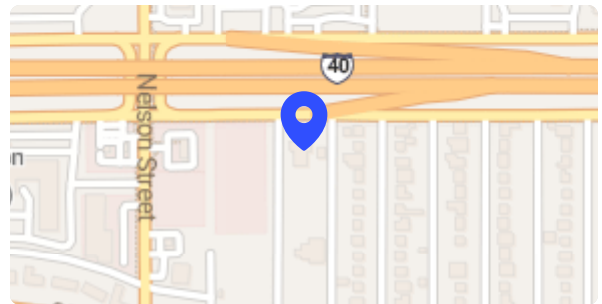

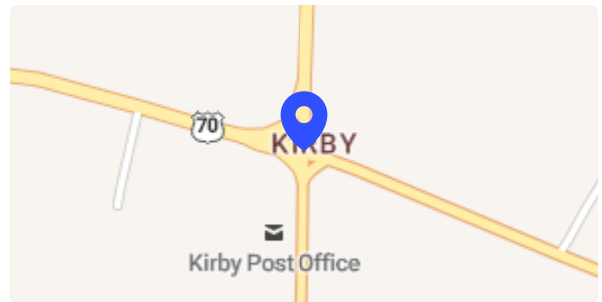
