Billy Joe Fulton, 84, of Alanreed, Texas, passed away on April 26, 2024.

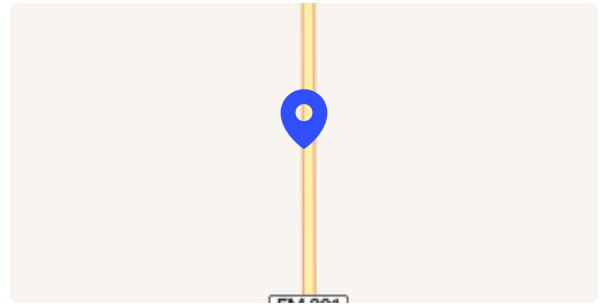

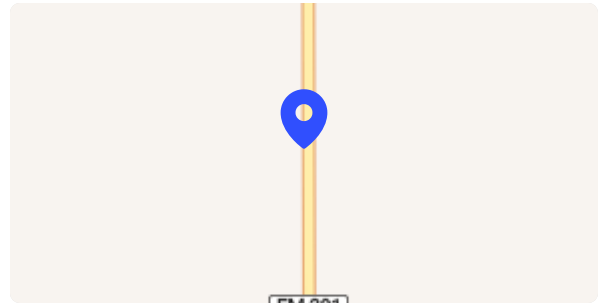
