# Iva Dean Browning Phillips

**I**va Dean Browning Phillips, 95, of Memphis, Texas died Friday, July 26, 2024 just shy of her 96th birthday, in Memphis, Texas.

Services will be 10:00 AM Wednesday, July 31, 2024 in the First Baptist Church in Memphis, Texas with Rev. Daniel Downey and Keith Martin, officiating. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery in Memphis.
