Clydene Hall of Allison, TX passed away on Monday, August 26, 2024 in Canadian, TX at the age of 79 years, 7 months and 27 days. Funeral services are scheduled for 10:00 AM on Thursday, August 29, 2024 at First Baptist Church in Allison, with Jess Little and Gary Hall officiating. Burial will follow at Zybach Cemetery in Briscoe, TX. The family will receive friends from 4:00PM until 6:00 PM on Wednesday at the funeral home.

Clydene was born on December 30, 1944 in Panhandle, TX to Bob and Marylu (Kinsey) Markham. The family soon moved to Allison, where she graduated from high school and would spend the rest of her lifetime. She married Lester Hall in New Mexico on September 9, 1961. He preceded her in death in 2015. Clydene loved her community and dedicated her life to making it a wonderful place to live. Though not officially elected, many considered her the “Mayor” of Allison because of her hard work and commitment to the town and its citizens.
