**W**illiam Rhode Chamberlain, 80, of Clarendon, Texas died Monday, December 2, 2024 in Amarillo, Texas.

Services will be 10:00 AM Friday, December 6, 2024 in the First Methodist Church in Clarendon with Rev. Chris Downer, officiating. Burial with Masonic Rites will follow in Citizens Cemetery in Clarendon.

Viewing will be held Thursday at the funeral home.

Will was born February 1, 1944 in Clarendon, Texas to William Park and Norma Rhode Chamberlain. He married the love of his life, Brenda Lane on November 28, 1963 in Turkey, Texas. 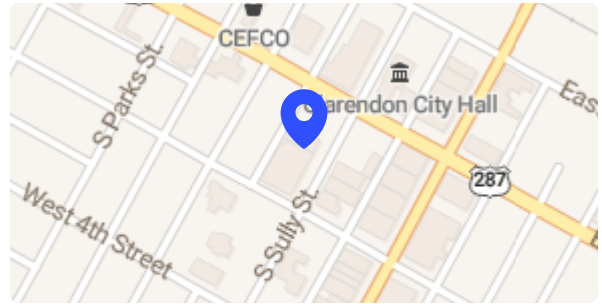

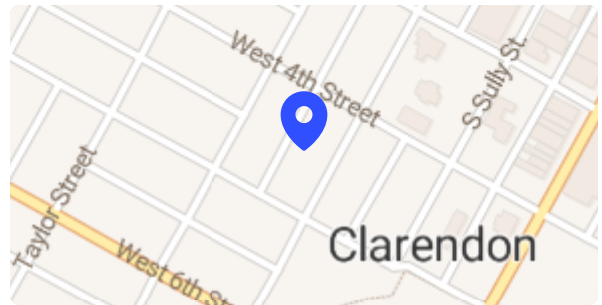

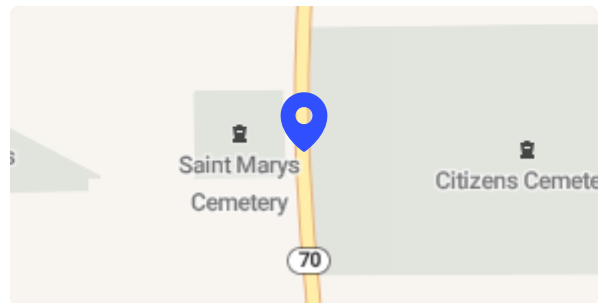
