Ottie Frances Dollins, 85, of Washington, Iowa passed away on March 26, 2025 in Clarendon.

Funeral services are scheduled for 3:00 PM Monday, March 31, 2025 at Robertson Saints Roost Chapel with Rev. Anthony Knowles officiating. Viewing and visitation will be held 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM prior to the service. Burial will follow at Citizens Cemetery in Clarendon.

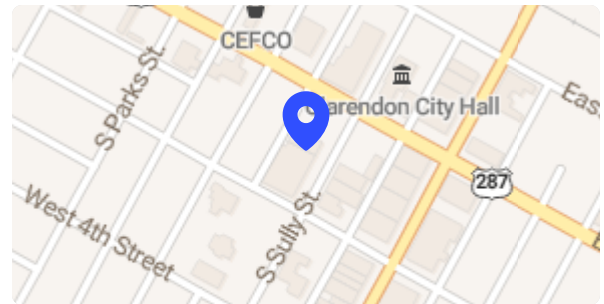

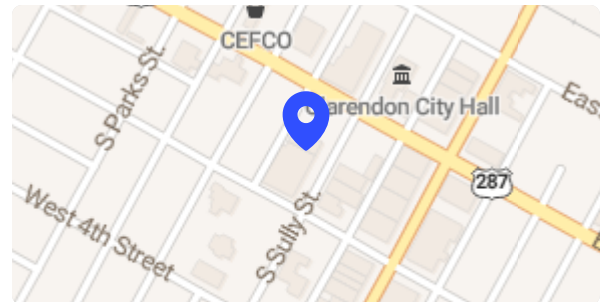
