**B**obby Tolbert of Shamrock, TX passed away Wednesday, February 18, 2026 in Alva, OK at the age of 43 years, 5 months and 16 days. A Memorial Service will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, February 27, 2026 at the First Methodist Church in Shamrock, with Daylon Kirkland officiating.

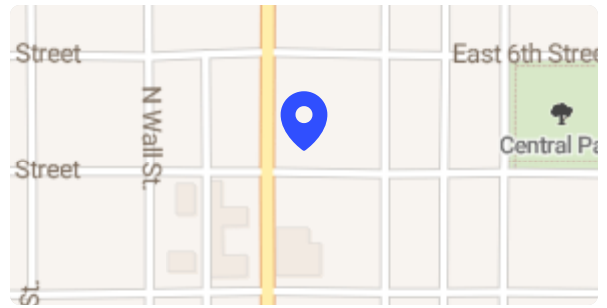
